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### **CLOSEST TO THE PIN ON ALL PAR 3'S"**

### **LONG DRIVE #TBD "in FAIRWAY"**

1. All four team members each hit tee shots.
2. The team then picks the shot that they feel is their best of the four.
3. All four team members place their ball at the positions of the shot they picked and all hit their next shot from that spot.
4. Continue this same routine until at least one ball reaches the green.
5. The team then picks the position of the ball they like best on the green and all putt from there. If the putt is not holed out by the team member putting he must mark his ball (unless he is the last man to putt). If he holes out his putt instead of marking it the score made with his putt is the one that has to be used for the team score. When any team member holes out his putt, there is no need for any other team member to putt after him.
